### **Are there any other day care?**

### **What are our teacher qualifications?**

The teacher is qualified in a variety of ways: 12 years of teaching in a Montessori school working with infants, toddlers and pre-schoolers. She is also certified in CPR and First Aid and has completed the Shaken Baby Syndrome.

### **What type of curriculum do you offer?**

We have planned activities in the following developmental areas: creative art, math and science, fine motor, large motor, music and movements, sensory, language, arts and dramatic play. We also apply baby sign language.

### **How do we handle discipline?**

We follow the following 5 point approach:

- Promote positive behaviors.
- Provide a positive model of acceptable behaviors.
- Maintain fairness, consistency, and reasonable expectations.
- Allow the expression of feelings.
- Think and plan for the future.

### **What is your exclusion policy?**

All illness exclusions are based on the provider division of licensing child care center rules and regulations. At your request, we will provide you with a list of specific exclusions.

### **Does my child have to be “potty” trained?**

No! When you are ready to start “potty” training, just let us know. We will help you in any and every way that we can.

### **Are meals included?**

Morning and afternoon snacks will be provided daily with 2% milk for toddlers. Lunch is provided by the parent.
